

## **Shereen Audi**

Shereen Audi was born in Amman in 1970, and graduated from the city's Institute of Fine Arts in 1992. Upon graduating, she undertook art and print-making courses at Amman's Darat al Funun and the Jordan National Gallery of Fine Arts alongside such established Arab artists as Khaled Khries, Nedim Kufi, and Mahmoud Obaidi.

Shereen's works are in many ways autobiographical, and illustrate the predicament and hardships faced by women in the Arab world, in addition to tackling the theme of Arab female identity. As Shereen notes, throughout her works, she strives to depict her inner self, and 'expose it without any rules or interference'.

Shereen's works have been received with acclaim around the Arab world in Jordan, Egypt, Algeria, Lebanon, and Bahrain. She lives and works in Amman.
