


The top five New York art shows this week

This show juxtaposes paintings by renowned Frenchman Jean Dubuffet (1901–85) with those by the Spanish contemporary artist Miquel Barceló, whose work is influenced by Dubuffet's figurative style and use of pronounced surface textures.
