

(e)merge recap: festival takes DC art global

In its second year, the (e)merge Art Festival at the Capitol Skyline Hotel featured an international roster of over 80 galleries exhibiting 152 artists from 24 countries. Three levels of installation, painting, sculpture, video and other media captivated guests over three days that also included performances by Worn Magazine featured artists such as Holly Bass, Sheldon Scott, and Andrew Wodzianski. Organized in large part by Leigh Connor and Jamie Smith of CONNORSMITH Gallery, the annual festival is propelling the growing (e)merging art scene in Washington onto the international stage.
