The CalArts Art Benefit and Auction is a fundraising effort in which more than 80 important works of art donated by CalArts alumni, faculty, and friends will be exhibited and sold this spring. This unprecendented initiative will fund the new John Baldessari Studio Building and endow scholarships for students at the CalArts School of Art.

The initiative launched with an opening reception for the exhibition at Regen Projects in West Hollywood, CA on February 25, 2014 and then traveled to Paula Cooper Gallery and Metro Pictures in New York from April 5 -19, 2014. The 32 works to be sold at auction by Christie's on May 14 will be on public view from May 8 to May 13 at Christie's New York, 20 Rockefeller Plaza.
