For the first time, the Parrish Art Museum's annual Midsummer Party will take place in its new home in Water Mill, NY, which opened to the public on November 10, 2012. Located on fourteen acres, the 34,400-square-foot, Herzog & de Meuron-designed building is the first art museum built on the East End of Long Island in more than a century and the cultural centerpiece and most recognizable architectural landmark in the region.
