ERIK PARKER BYE BYE BABYLON 293 Tenth Avenue September 6-October 13


Immediately following Parker's major solo exhibition at the Aldrich Contemporary Art Museum, Paul Kasmin Gallery will present the New York premiere of his new series of jungle paintings. For Parker, jungle paintings allow him to escape into custom-made exotic locales without having to leave his Brooklyn studio. He draws inspiration from the imaginary landscapes of Henri Rousseau—who never left his native France, and Joseph Yoakum—who mixed his memories of his own travels into his visualizations of unknown cities and countries



SAINT CLAIR CEMIN SIX

515 W. 27th Street and Broadway Mall September 6-October 13; Outdoors September 5-November 2012

For his inaugural exhibition at the gallery, the Brazilian-born sculptor Saint Clair Cemin will present six new figurative and abstract sculptures. On view concurrently, the artist will make his NYC public art debut with seven outdoor works installed along the Broadway Mall as presented by Paul Kasmin Gallery in collaboration with the Broadway Mall Association. Crossing surrealism and folk art with classical and High Modernist forms, Cemin's sculptures, in polished stainless steel and traditional black-lacquered resin, convey the complexities of surface and movement. The outdoor installation will open September 5 and remain on view through November 2012.



WILLIAM COPLEY 293 Tenth Avenue October 18-November 24

Following two major retrospectives of the artist's work at Museum Frieder Burda in Baden-Baden, and the Max Ernst Museum in Nruhl, Germany, Paul Kasmin Gallery will present an exhibition focusing on William Copley's use of patriotic symbols.



MAKOTO SAITO 515 W. 27th Street October 18-November 24

For Saito's first solo gallery exhibition in the United States, Paul Kasmin Gallery will present paintings from his new series inspired by acclaimed Italian filmmaker Federico Fellini. Through software specially developed by Saito, the artist creates an intersection between painting and photography, grafting photographs into large-scale paintings, which layer images from varying sources.

The gallery will present a new, never-before-seen body of work by David LaChapelle at both of its Chelsea locations.
