Today, the Art Show continues to be an ideal venue for New Yorkers and visitors to connect with artists and dealers and purchase exquisite works." The **2013 Art Show** leads a contingent of art fairs around New York City such as The Armory Show, VOLTA, INDEPENDENT, and SCOPE, which also take place during the same week.

**The Art Show's** considered, curated exhibitions offer a dynamic selection of artworks—juxtaposing modern masters and cutting edge contemporary works in exhibitions from galleries all over the country. The anticipated thematic group shows include "**Cubism and Pop**" at **Richard Feigen & Co.**, and "**20<sup>th</sup> Century Impressionism**" at **Acquavella Galleries, Inc.** ADAA also welcomes two first-time exhibiting galleries, **303 Gallery** and **Yossi Milo Gallery**.
