New York - Symbolic art is one of the oldest records of human behavior. *Gathering the Scattered*, Richard Gabriele's first exhibition with Fred Torres Gallery, demonstrates the evolution of symbols in his work from the past ten years.

With some paintings on loan from private collections, the exhibition includes a variety of **drawings**, **watercolors and oil paintings** in the shape of **birds**, **figures and abstract forms**. Gabriele's interest in abstract painting began in 2013 when, "the underlying feeling of creativity became the subject."
