For another twist on Pop, in this case as dismantled and reinterpreted by a younger generation of artists, there is “POPcentric,” opening Wednesday at **GERING & LÓPEZ GALLERY** in Midtown. The show of work by 14 artists includes a video piece by Fischerspooner, the electronic music-art duo; sculptures by Liz Craft of a hairy character who looks like Cousin Itt from “The Addams Family”; and paintings by Dexter Dalwood, known for his cartoonish imagined renditions of the homes and playgrounds of the famous and infamous, like Kurt Cobain, Senator Joseph R.
