Comparable mirrors have recently been through Christies saleroom's in both Europe and the US, dating from the early 18th century and the late 19th century; this mirror falls into the late nineteenth century group. The quality of glass-work & the colour in all the Nineteenth century mirrors that have been on the open market, points to one highly capable but unknown venetian workshop; perhaps even one lone maker.
