Primavera was the design studio of the Parisian department store Printemps. It was established in 1912 by Rene Guillere and his wife Charlotte. Charlotte was a furniture designer and Rene sourced artists from all over France to discover new talent. He commissioned established designers to create a range of objects from furniture and bronzes to ceramics. Jacques Adnet, Marcel Guillemard and Colette Gueden were among those who produced work for the studio.
