



1 Inspired by the Forties designer Jean Royère, this gilt, wrought-iron, 12-arm chandelier measures 60 x 110cm diameter, and costs £3,000. It is available from Tyson, at The Blanchard Collective in Wiltshire.

2 This hand-coopered log bin made from untreated English hardwood, bound with hazel 'hoops', measures 63 x 66cm diameter, and costs £2,070, to order, at Rose Uniacke.

3 'Squiggle' wallpaper, 52cm wide, is a new design by Vivienne Westwood, inspired by a fabric from her 1981-82 fashion collection, Pirate. It comes in five colourways, and costs £55 a 10-metre roll, from Cole & Son.

4 The 'Taj Mahal' fire screen with tea-light holders measures 53 x 10 x 50cm, and costs £109, from Plümo.

5 Sharyn Storrier Lyneham uses digital-imaging techniques to design her cushions. Her 'Chandelier' cushion (left) - pictured here printed on hemp, but also made in silk, linen or silk/rayon velvet - shows a collage of photographs taken on her travels. The 'Jewels' cushion (right), features a photograph of paste jewellery belonging to her mother, and is available in silk, linen or hemp.
