2 / SHELL GAME

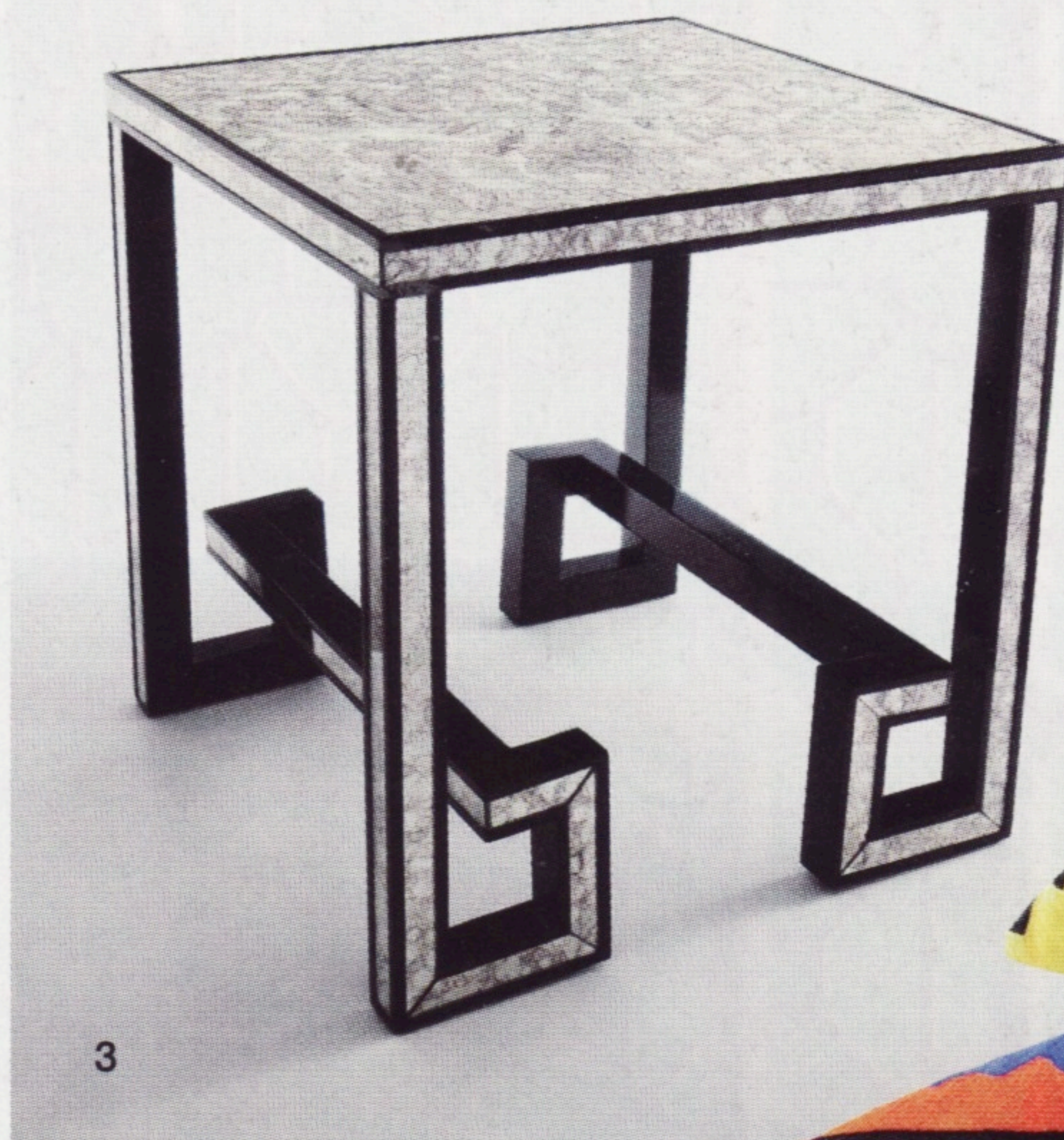
