

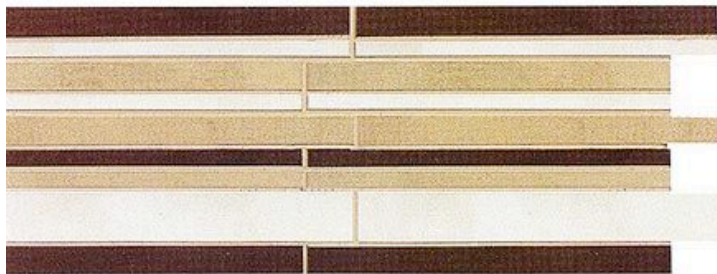

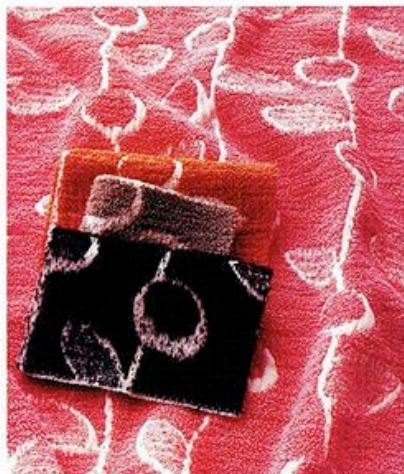


Crossville
